COVID-19 Guidelines

*Nov. 5, 2020 * 9 a.m. – 2 p.m.*

This year's **Golf Tournament** at **Pelican Point Golf Course** will be conducted somewhat different from past years due to the COVID-19 virus. This guideline assumes that our region is in at least a Phase 3 of the Governor's COVID-19 order. If Phase 2 is reimplemented, new guidelines will be communicated.

General Rules: Upon arrival, teams will be directed to their carts and will be asked to drive their carts to **the driving range to pick up breakfast** from the Breakfast Sponsor. Social distancing should be adhered to by keeping 6 feet apart from one another whenever possible and wearing masks when in closer proximity to others. 2 riders per cart is allowed.

Registration: Golf Tournament participants, whether golfers or supplier/contractor tent participants will not be allowed to register on-site, as that is gathering, per Pelican Point. Everything must be pre-registered, assigned & paid in advance except for chance games (i.e. 50/50 Money Pot, Putting Contest, etc.) which will be sold via a traveling person on the course.

Golf Genius App: All teams must have 1 person per group install the Golf Genius app on their cell phone. The application is a digital scorecard/leaderboard that allows teams/players to enter their hole scores on a mobile device. By viewing the scoreboard on a mobile device, players will know all scores in the field. Players will receive an email prior to play with their team's code. A second code will be available to view the leaderboard.

Suppliers/Contractors:

- o 1 supplier/contractor per hole. No suppliers may setup at the Pelican Point Clubhouse.
- o 2 people per 10x10 tent space (may have more than one tent) – No More than 1 vehicle per hole.
- o Masks & gloves are required for suppliers when serving food.
- o No self-service by participants. Suppliers must serve food and drinks to players.
- o Must use Food Grade Disinfectant for cleaning.

Prizes, Networking and Gumbo:

All prizes will be announced and awarded at the Gumbo Cook-off, immediately after play completes i.e. between 2:30 p.m. and 3:30 p.m. The awards ceremony will be held **at 3:30 p.m.** The Gumbo Cook-Off will be held at **River Parishes Community College**, adjacent to Pelican Point.

The **Gumbo Cook-Off and Supplier/Contractor Showcase** will take place outside at **River Parishes Community College**. All cooking teams and supplier tents/tailgates will be assigned a designated location to set up ahead of time. Upon arrival, a volunteer will direct participants where to go.

Cooking teams and supplier tents/tailgates should adhere to social distancing by keeping 6 feet apart from one another and wearing masks when in closer proximity to others.

When serving guests, it is recommended to:

- o Wear masks & gloves.
- o Serve guests vs. self-service by participants. Teams and suppliers should serve food and drinks to guests.
- o Use Food Grade Disinfectant for cleaning.

We encourage networking by being responsible, i.e. keeping 6 ft. distance when possible and wearing masks when in closer proximity to one another.
